Instructions: Your community is opening a new Recreational Park. The mayor has asked you to write a proposal describing the main area. Write your proposal for the committee.

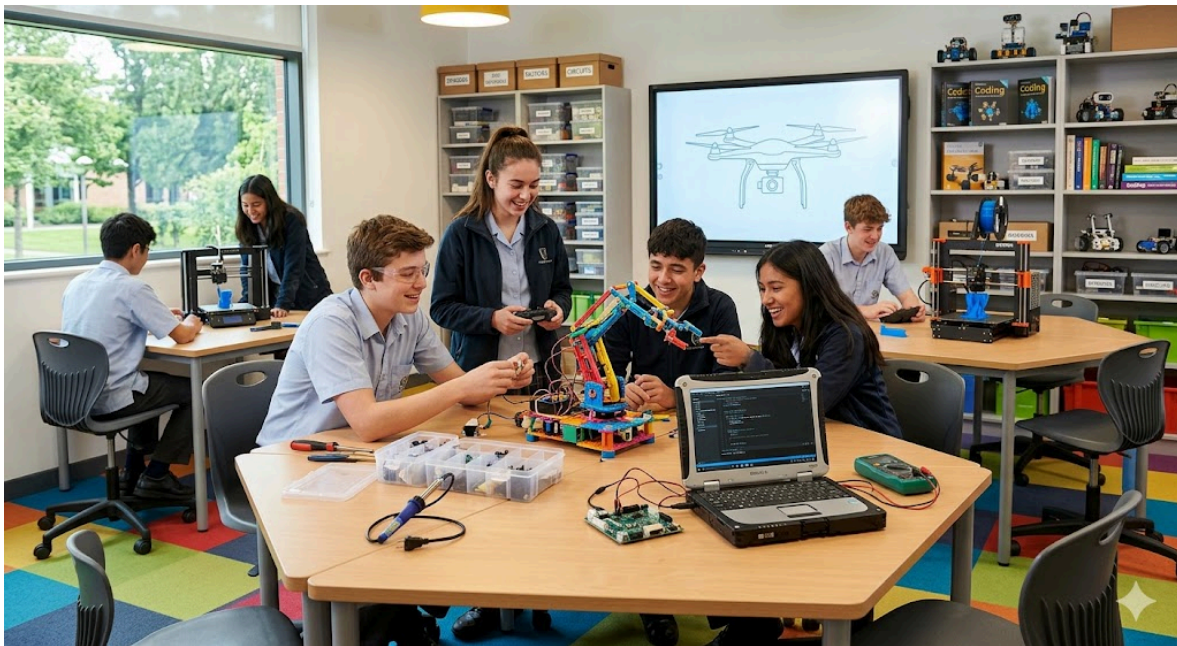
In your writing, you must:
